**SCHOOL PROFILE**

St. Francis' Convent School, Agra is an offshoot of the Clarist Franciscan Missionaries of the Most blessed Sacrament (CFMSS), an Institute founded by Mother Seraphina Farolfi of Italy. It is an English medium school affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education and the middle and secondary curriculum is based on NCERT.

Following the principles of Mother Seraphina, the school is an effective agent in promoting the integral formation of the children.

## STAFF AND EMPLOYEES

There are approx 58 teaching and non teaching staff members who play pivotal role in the teaching learning process with utmost dedication and labour. There are approx 14 helping staff members who maintain the hygiene and cleanliness in the school premises.

## STUDENTS

To empower students and to develop responsibility, leadership skills and community feeling in them the school cabinet is formed. It comprises of the Head boy, Head Girl, Vice Head Boy, Vice Head Girl, Jr. Head Boy, Jr. Head Girl, House Captains and Vice Captains, Discipline In-charges, Sports In-charges and Club In-charges.

The House system begins from class III. Captains and Vice-captains of four houses Emerald, Ruby, Sapphire and Topaz are elected by the students and teachers. The strength of students lie in abiding by the code of pupil's conduct.

## ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

- Learning is the partnership between dedicated teachers and motivated students. The faculty brings a depth of intellectual expertise and academic curiosity to the classroom by experiential learning and happy classroom teaching.
- The achievement of student is reviewed continually through class test, Periodic test, Term end exams and revision tests.
- The academic session commences from April and ends in March.
- In AISSE 2025 Ridhima Singh topped with 98.2%, Divyam Jain secured 97.2% and Ridhima Arora and Abhinav Thakur secured 96.6%.
- We follow common syllabus and exams schedule meant for all the schools of the congregation.
- CBSE SAFAL (Mock / Pilot Exam) was conducted successfully from 29<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> October 2025 for classes VI and IX.

## CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

To enable students to recognize and realize their talents and become responsible, a plethora of carefully selected activities are regularly organized in the school.

- Students of class IX went on class picnic to Lohagarh Farms Gurugram on November 7, 2025.
- Students of classes VI to VIII went to Adventure Island, Rohini on November 8, 2025.
- Students of classes III to V were taken to Rajgarh Farms and Resort Sadabad on November 13, 2025
- Students of classes I-II & Pre-primary went to Khel Gaon on November 20 & November 12, 2025 respectively.
- To enhance social skills, boost confidence and to promote well being, the Principal and staff went on a two days trip to Udaipur in February 2026 .
- Our students participated & brought laurels in prestigious Inter-school competitions like APSA and Rainbow - the Archdiocesan inter-school competitions conducted at St. Peter's College, Agra.

## SCHOOL ASSEMBLY

- Our institution is committed to inculcate in its students social sensitivity and the sense of sacredness of life. Our students have contributed the provisions generously which were delivered to many charitable institutions and homes.

- Small classrooms and inadequate infrastructure.


## **AREAS TO IMPROVE**


- Focus on critical thinking and scientific temperament.
